
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

(Pakistan) According to a Gallup International Snap Poll conducted in March 2020, over 3 in 5 (62%) Pakistanis feel that the threat from Coronavirus is exaggerated. Over 1 in 3 (35%) see the virus as a real threat. A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, "Do you agree or disagree that the threat from the coronavirus is exaggerated?" In response to this question, 62% Pakistanis claimed the threat is exaggerated while 35% believe that the threat of the virus is not exaggerated. (Gallup Pakistan)

632-02 [A vast majority of UAE working professionals claim the Coronavirus has impacted their business \(Click for Details\)](#)

(UAE) Although cancelled or delayed business trips emerged as the most visible initial impact of the virus, declining sales is expected to be the greatest commercial woe in the future. As Coronavirus takes a toll on global and regional economies, YouGov ran a survey among 220 working professionals belonging to the senior management in various companies (senior business managers and above) between 9th- 15th March to understand the impact of the pandemic on their business and the overall economy. Four in five (79%) of the surveyed business professionals claimed the Coronavirus had a large or moderate impact on their business. 13% said the impact was minor and only 6% claimed to have no impact at all. (UAE) YouGov's COVID-19 tracker continues to measure residents' response to the outbreak. As the number of confirmed cases and deaths due to the Coronavirus rise in the UAE and Saudi Arabia, it's perhaps unsurprising that residents in these two countries are getting more nervous about the outbreak. New data from YouGov's COVID-19 tracker (11th- 24th March) shows that the level of fear has risen among people and seven in ten (69%) now say they are very or fairly scared they will contract the disease, up from 62% last week. Fear is slightly more among KSA residents - 71% as compared to people in the UAE (66%). (YouGov)

(Nigeria) In commemoration of World Water Day, which holds on the 22nd of March every year, NOIPolls conducted a public opinion poll on access to clean water. The poll explored the accessibility of water to Nigerians, the quality and treatment of drinking water and challenges faced in accessing clean water. The poll revealed that sachet water popularly known as pure water is the main source of drinking water for Nigerians while borehole is the main source of water for household use in the country. More findings showed that 64 percent of respondents (except for those whose only source of drinking water is sachet and bottled water) do not treat the water in any way before drinking irrespective of the source. (UK) Health-conscious Brits are increasingly opening their eyes to food delivery apps – but they still need some convincing. Deliveroo recently announced it is investing £1 million in developing takeaway brands and supporting restaurants to offer better options for health-conscious customers. The move came after a 181% uptick in healthy orders over the past three years. It points to a wider trend in the food delivery industry. Growing numbers of people with healthy diets say they would consider ordering from delivery apps Just Eat, Deliveroo and Uber Eats, YouGov BrandIndex data shows. (YouGov)

(UK) The latest wave of our coronavirus tracker shows a dramatic increase in Government approval, with even a majority of Labour voters thinking they are doing a good job. After another week of difficult Government decisions, including having to mandate on Monday that the public follow social distancing guidelines, the latest wave of our weekly tracker poll shows the public are still overwhelmingly supportive. Over seven in ten (72%) now think they are doing well, up from 59% last week, with just two in ten (21%)

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now thinking they are doing badly, down from 31% last week. The biggest shift has been among those who voted for the Labour Party in December, with a majority (56%) of them now thinking the Government is handling this crisis well, compared to just 38% a week ago. (UK) Sports fans say they want to see classic highlights, and the likes of Joe Wickes and Mr Motivator fill in for postponed sports coverage. Up and down the country British sports fans are lamenting the loss of virtually all live sports coverage, as leagues and competitions postpone matches due to coronavirus. Yet, the show must go on, and a wealth of new content has appeared to fill the void. But what content are British sports fans most interested in watching while on lockdown? A third of Brits who watch sport (33%) say airtime should be filled with classic replays and highlights of games gone by. More interesting however, are the 23% of sports fans who want to see interactive exercise programmes on TV. (YouGov)

(UK) Nothing in living memory has changed daily life in Britain faster than the COVID-19 (also known as coronavirus) outbreak. With most of us now cooped up inside for at least the next two and a half weeks, YouGov takes a look at the impact the pandemic has had on some of our daily habits. With journalists the world over having been scratching their heads as to how to reverse declining audience numbers, it turns out the solution has been staring them in the face all along: start a global pandemic. Three in ten Brits say they are now paying attention to the news because of coronavirus. When you take into account that 61% of Britons say they normally pay attention to the news anyway, this means that the vast majority of people who don't usually engage with the news are now doing so. (UK) Trust in broadsheet newspaper journalists has hit a six-year high since the 2019 general election, YouGov research shows, but Britons remain sceptical of other papers. YouGov research shows that trust in the press took a knock during the 2019 general election, but as concerned Britons turn to the media for vital news and advice on the spread of coronavirus, are things improving? YouGov tracking reveals that trust in newspapers is polarised, with upmarket newspapers such as The Times and The Telegraph seeing a six-percentage point increase since December 2019 but other papers doing less well. Two fifths (40%) of Britons say they trust journalists at broadsheet publications to tell the truth, the highest percentage of overall trust since November 2014. (YouGov)

632-10 [Coronavirus: Young Brits most worried about jobs and wages \(Click for Details\)](#)

(UK) Young people worry more than any other age group that coronavirus will impact their finances, the unemployment rate and wages in the long-term. Two thirds of Brits now believe coronavirus will do long-lasting damage to the UK economy, but the figures are especially high among younger people. Seven in ten 18- to 24-year-olds worry that the coronavirus will harm the job market and cause higher unemployment for a long time. This figure drops for every subsequent age group. People aged 65 and older are the least anxious with just over half sharing the concern. (YouGov)

632-11 [Public split over Britain's ability to recover from coronavirus outbreak - but Conservatives twice as positive as Labour and Lib Dems \(Click for Details\)](#)

(UK) A new online survey by Ipsos MORI shows that Britons are split on the long-term impact of the coronavirus outbreak on the country. Just under half of Britons aged 18-75 (45%) think that even though the coronavirus outbreak will be tough, Britain will be stronger when it gets through it, while 40% think the country will be weaker because of it for years to come. In November 2012, after several years of being affected by the economic downturn, Britons were more pessimistic about how long the country would take to recover from the impact of the financial crash. Then, only 31% of the British public believed Britain would come out stronger, while over half (56%) believed it would be weaker. (Ipsos MORI)

632-12 [Coronavirus Response: Hospitals Rated Best, News Media Worst \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) Americans are generally positive in their evaluations of how each of nine leaders and institutions has handled the response to the coronavirus situation. Eight of the nine receive majority positive ratings -- led by U.S. hospitals, at 88% approval. Only the news media gets a more negative than positive review. About four in five Americans approve of the way their state government and government agencies such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the National Institutes of Health are handling the coronavirus outbreak. Similarly, 83% of parents of children younger than 18 rate their children's school or daycare positively for its handling of the situation. And 82% of U.S. workers rate their employer's response positively. (Gallup USA)

632-13 [Most U.S. Adults Expect Long-Term COVID-19 Disruption \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) As COVID-19 ravages the U.S., more state and local officials are placing stringent restrictions on residents' activities in an effort to curb the spread of the virus. Two-thirds of Americans say they are following news stories about the pandemic "very closely," with the same percentage saying the situation has disrupted their lives -- either a great deal (30%) or a fair amount (36%). Nearly as many expect it to take a few more months (51%) or longer (12%) for the level of disruption to travel, work, school and public events to improve,



while 36% say it will only be a few more weeks. Some Americans are feeling the disruption more acutely than others. These include younger adults, those considered high-risk for serious complications from COVID-19, college graduates, Democrats and Democratic-leaning independents, those following the news about coronavirus "very closely," and those who live in cities or suburban areas. 632-14 [Americans Increasingly Expect Economic Recession \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) In a little less than two weeks, the percentage of Americans who believe an economic recession is very likely to occur in the U.S. because of the COVID-19 virus has increased from 38% to 61%. Another 31% currently believe a recession is somewhat likely to occur, while just 8% do not think it will happen. Democrats were originally more likely than Republicans to believe this, and they remain that way. In fact, barely more than one in three Republicans, versus about eight in 10 Democrats, say an economic recession is very likely. Another 46% of Republicans and 15% of Democrats say it is somewhat likely. (Gallup USA)

632-15 [Young workers likely to be hard hit as COVID-19 strikes a blow to restaurants and other service sector jobs \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) COVID-19 and the coronavirus that causes it are proving to be not only a public health crisis but also an economic one. With calls for social distancing, service sector jobs that depend on customer-provider interactions or involve the congregation of large numbers of people are likely to take a huge hit. Workers in industries such as restaurants, hotels, child care services, retail trade and transportation services are at a higher risk of losing their jobs. Nearly one-in-four U.S. workers – 38.1 million out of 157.5 million – are employed in the industries most likely to feel an immediate impact from the COVID-19 outbreak, according to a Pew Research Center analysis of government data. Among the most vulnerable are workers in retail trade (10% of all workers) and food services and drinking places (6%). In total, these two industries employ nearly 26 million Americans. (PEW)

632-16 [Most Americans are confident hospitals can handle the needs of the seriously ill during COVID-19 outbreak \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) Doctors, nurses and other hospital staff around the country have raised concerns about a shortage of medical supplies during the COVID-19 pandemic. But the U.S. public is generally confident that hospitals and medical centers will be able to care for seriously ill people during the outbreak, according to a new Pew Research Center survey. About seven-in-ten U.S. adults (71%) say they are very or somewhat confident that hospitals and medical centers in their area can handle the needs of seriously ill people during the outbreak. Around two-thirds (68%) say this about hospitals and medical centers around the



country, according to the survey, conducted March 19 to 24. By comparison, a smaller share of Americans (54%) say they are very or somewhat confident that nursing homes in their area can handle the needs of seriously ill people during the outbreak. (PEW)

632-17 [Most Americans don't see Trump as religious; fewer than half say they think he's Christian](#) (Click for Details)

(USA) President Donald Trump has often used religious language while in office, and he has surrounded himself with evangelical leaders and supported conservative Christian causes. But Trump's personal religious beliefs and practices have not been as public. Indeed, half of U.S. adults either say they're not sure what Trump's religion is (34%) or that he has no religion (16%), while just 33% say he's Protestant. And Americans overall don't think Trump is particularly religious: A majority say Trump is "not too" (23%) or "not at all" (40%) religious, while 28% say he's "somewhat" religious and only 7% say he's "very religious," according to a new Pew Research Center survey. 632-18 [More than half of U.S. households have some investment in the stock market](#) (Click for Details)

(USA) Uncertainty driven by the current coronavirus outbreak has caused the U.S. stock market to wipe away three years of gains in a matter of weeks. The steep fall in stock prices comes at a time when roughly four-in-ten U.S. workers (41%) have access to employer- or union-sponsored retirement plans, with the values of many of these plans linked to the stock market. Data from 2016, the latest available, provides key insights into the broad reach of stock market investment in the United States. While a relatively small share of American families (14%) are directly invested in individual stocks, a majority (52%) have some level of investment in the market. Most of this comes in the form of retirement accounts such as 401(k)s. (PEW)

632-19 [Honest, genuine and community-minded leaders focused on the public interest score highest for Trust](#) (Click for Details)

(Australia) A special Roy Morgan survey on 'Trust' and 'Distrust' of government and business leaders conducted in March shows being honest and genuine is the most valued trait for leaders with a high level of Trust. This trait was mentioned by over a quarter (27%) of respondents in relation to political leaders and even more, 30%, for business leaders according to the survey of 974 Australians aged 14+. Another personality trait to rate highly was being community-minded and with a focus on the public interest mentioned by 15% of respondents for political leaders and 12% for business leaders. ► **MULTICOUNTRY STUDIES****632-20 [Public divided on whether isolation, travel bans prevent COVID-19 spread; border closures become more acceptable](#) ([Click for Details](#))**

According to the last Global Advisor survey from Ipsos, the coronavirus crisis is seen as threatening to both health and finances. More than half of people in many large countries think the restrictions on travel and mandates for self-isolation will not stop the spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus, according to the latest Ipsos survey. In a poll of nearly 14,000 people conducted online between March 19 to 21, majorities in eight out of the 14 countries surveyed agreed social distancing measures such as travel bans, and self-isolation will not prevent the spread of the virus. Majorities in Japan (62%), India (61%), Mexico (59%), Brazil (56%), Germany and Vietnam (55%), and Australia (52%) believe social distancing will not work, while majorities in countries like China (61%), Canada (59%), Italy (57%) and France (56%) disagree. **632-21 [Locust Swarms Compound Food Worries in East Africa](#) ([Click for Details](#))**

In the past month, large swarms of locusts have devastated crops across large swaths of East Africa, threatening the livelihoods and the food supply of millions who were already struggling to afford food before the locust invasions. While swarms have been spotted in 10 countries, places such as Kenya and Ethiopia -- where the majority of residents say they could not afford food at times in the past year -- have been among the hardest hit. Although aid agencies are working with local governments to combat the locusts, they currently lack the equipment and funding they need, and amid the COVID-19 outbreak, experts can no longer travel to countries to help train the local communities to fight the spread of the pests. This poses tremendous risk for the communities affected, not only in Africa but also the Middle East, where the locusts are expected to spread in the next month. ([Gallup USA](#))

#### Synopsis:

Gilani's Gallopedia provides a statistical compilation of 134 national polls and 13 multi-country polls of opinion on COVID-19 released during January 2020 – March 2020. With a modest level of searching we have traced a total of 147 polls covering 49 Countries. The polls touch upon the following key issues: General awareness about the virus, perceived threat, impact on daily life, satisfaction with government responses to the situation, and financial impact of Coronavirus. Links are available for those with further interest. We hope to update this exercise on a weekly basis.
