(South Korea) South Koreans are headed to the polls April 15 as the COVID-19 pandemic continues. While South Korea has been affected by the outbreak, it has flattened the curve of new infections and is proceeding with the election with certain protective measures in place. A total of 300 seats in the country's legislative body, the National Assembly, are at stake. It's unclear how the country's handling of the coronavirus may influence the election results. But a Pew Research Center survey conducted in spring 2019 examined South Koreans' attitudes toward their democracy more broadly. (PEW)

635-02 [Urban Indians favour a lockdown extension but many worry about availability of essential items](#) ([Click for Details](#))

(India) Although fear about contracting the virus has stabilised over time due to staying indoors, many people have concerns relating the pandemic. Data from YouGov's latest survey run among urban Indians between 7th-10th April shows that people's expectations are in line with the government's decision to extend the lockdown and most of them (76%) want the lockdown to continue till the number of COVID-19 positive cases in the country do not reduce. 18% on the other hand hoped for the lockdown to be lifted post 15th April so that people could go back to work and prevent further economic damage. As people have been staying home for roughly three weeks now, data from YouGov's ongoing COVID-19 tracker shows that fear levels among people have stabilised over time and this week there has been a marginal decline in the number of people saying they are very or fairly scared of contracting the virus – at 64%, down from 66% last week. 635-03 [1 in 10 Pakistanis \(9%\) claim that someone has confided in them about having suicidal thoughts](#) ([Click for Details](#))

(Pakistan) According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 10 Pakistanis (9%) claim that someone has confided in them about having suicidal thoughts. A representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Has anyone ever spoken to you about having suicidal thoughts?" In response, 9% said yes while 91% said no. Roughly, 10.8 million adult



Pakistanis had someone speak to them about having suicidal thoughts. Urban-Rural Breakdown: Similar proportion of urban (8%) and rural (9%) respondents reported someone speaking to them about having suicidal thought. ([Gallup Pakistan](#))

635-04 [Increasing number of UAE and KSA residents are concerned about job and income loss due to the Corona](#) ([Click for Details](#))

(UAE) In addition to this, most residents think the pandemic will incur long-lasting damage to their respective economies. The latest data from YouGov's survey run between 8th- 15th April shows an increasing number of people in the UAE and KSA are concerned about the loss of job or salary due to the ongoing Coronavirus crisis. The proportion of respondents who said this has increased from 44% to 51% this week. Notably, UAE residents are much more worried about this outcome as compared to people in KSA (64% vs 38%). In both the countries, concern over job loss was seen more among expats than locals. In the UAE, Western (74%) and Asian expats (68%) appeared more nervous about this scenario as compared to the Emiratis (46%). Similarly, in KSA, expats are more anxious about losing their livelihoods than locals (56% vs 30%). ([YouGov MENA](#))

635-05 [72 Percent of Nigerians Are Concerned About The Lockdown Mainly Due To Hunger](#) ([Click for Details](#))

(Nigeria) NOIPolls conducted its second public opinion poll on COVID-19 to gauge the perception of Nigerians regarding awareness, lockdown order as well as ascertain the level of concern in the country. The poll result revealed that almost all adult Nigerians (99 percent) are aware of the outbreak of corona virus disease in the country. Trend analysis shows a significant 15 percent increase in the proportion of Nigerians who are aware of the outbreak when current results are compared with figures obtained in March. It is shocking to know at this stage that some Nigerians (6 percent) consider the COVID-19 outbreak in Nigeria to be fake. During the survey, respondents in this category disclosed that they believe the outbreak is real in other countries but not in Nigeria, while some mentioned that they don't believe it is real because they have not seen anybody infected by the virus in their states, others specified that it is a propaganda and a means for government to embezzle funds. 635-06 [Support for the Government is holding up despite increasing criticism](#) (Click for Details)

(UK) Brits are still supportive of the Government's coronavirus response despite mounting criticism over a lack of PPE and testing, YouGov's latest figures show. There has been a notable uptick in criticism of the Government's handling of the coronavirus outbreak this week. Both the press and opposition parties have questioned the Government's exit strategy, as well as whether they should be doing more to increase the number of tests and access to PPE for staff in the NHS and care homes.



However, our latest polling shows that this has not translated into a drop in support for the Government. Two thirds (66%) still say the Government is doing well at handling the outbreak, compared to just under three in ten (28%) who think they are handling it badly. (YouGov)

635-07 [COVID-19: Brits turn to corner shops for essentials](#) (Click for Details)

(UK) Brits are making fewer trips to all types of food stores, but nearly a quarter say they've shopped more in corner shops since the lockdown. YouGov research shows that while over a third of Brits have shopped less frequently at their local corner shop since the lockdown came into effect three weeks ago, 23% have in fact used it more. This is the largest uptick among all the shop types in the survey. The figures seem to support news reports of Brits turning to corner shops as supermarkets struggle to keep up with increased demand as a result of the coronavirus outbreak. (YouGov)

635-08 [COVID-19: Most NHS staff worry they'll infect those they live with](#) (Click for Details)

(UK) Three quarters of NHS staff fear for their own health and most are also worried about infecting those they live with, prompting 34% to change their housing arrangements. NHS staff have continued to raise concerns over the availability of personal protective equipment (LINK) to prevent the spread of COVID-19 as they work on the front lines in the battle against the virus. New YouGov polling of NHS workers now reveals that the vast majority are concerned for their own health, and others have had to alter their living arrangements to protect those they live with from the virus. Overall, 78% of NHS staff say they are worried for their personal health due to COVID-19, with 28% saying they are very worried. Only 22% say they aren't worried for their health. (YouGov)

635-09 [Sports Direct: a COVID-19 cautionary tale? \(Click for Details\)](#)

(UK) Sports Direct recently attempted to keep its stores open despite the Government's COVID-19 lockdown – arguing that, with gyms closed and Brits stuck indoors, exercise equipment counts as an essential service. YouGov polling reveals that the public overwhelmingly disagrees. Some 95% of Brits believe that sports equipment stores are not key services, and just 3% say that they are. Sports Direct was clearly on the wrong side of popular opinion, and judging from its hasty reverse-ferret – closing its high street locations and apologising after a public backlash – its senior management knows it. 635-10 [Majority of Britons support government using mobile data for surveillance to tackle coronavirus crisis \(Click for Details\)](#)

(UK) Despite earlier concerns about the use of data tracking by the government, the British public appear to be more comfortable with its use in the fight against coronavirus. In a new online survey by Ipsos MORI, a majority of the public say they would support the use of mobile phone roaming data for surveillance by the Government in a range of ways to help limit the effect of coronavirus. The British public support tracking those diagnosed with coronavirus, and those that they have been in close contact with, in order to advise those individuals to self-isolate themselves. Almost two-thirds (65%) support this, including 28% that strongly support it. Only 16% oppose it. (Ipsos MORI)

635-11 [Americans' Reported Use of Face Masks Surges in Past Week \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) Since news of the novel coronavirus first broke in the U.S., Americans have received conflicting opinions about the efficacy of face masks in containing the spread of the disease. However, as federal, state and local authorities have increasingly advised -- and in some cases mandated -- the use of face masks in public when social distancing is not possible, Americans have quickly adopted the guidelines. The Centers for Disease Control officially recommended the use of face masks in public places on April 3. Gallup polling since April 7 finds the percentage of Americans who report that they have worn a mask on their face outside of their homes has increased from 38% to 62% in just one week. An additional 24% of U.S. adults now say they are considering wearing masks outside the home and just 14% say they have not considered it. (Gallup USA)

635-12 [Half in U.S. Plan to Spend Relief Money on Bills, Essentials \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) With the first direct payments to U.S. adults from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act set to hit bank accounts this week, 35% of U.S. adults intend to use the money primarily to pay

bills. Another 16% say they will purchase essential items like food or gas with the money. Twenty-nine percent expect to save or invest it, with smaller percentages planning to donate it to charity or spend it on nonessential items. (Gallup USA)

635-13 [U.S. Economic Confidence Shows Record Drop \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) Americans' evaluations of the economy have abruptly turned negative amid the coronavirus pandemic. Gallup's Economic Confidence Index is now -32, down from +22 in March. The 54-point drop is the largest one-month change in Gallup's trend dating back to 1992, and it comes on the heels of last month's 19-point drop, which had been one of the largest monthly declines to date. Just two months ago, economic confidence was the highest it had been in 20 years. Although the current figures represent the largest short-term decline, economic confidence remains higher now than it was during the Great Recession. The Economic Confidence Index was -72 in October 2008, just after the financial crisis started. The index has a theoretical range of +100 to -100. (Gallup USA)

635-14 [In U.S., More Fear COVID-19 Illness Than Financial Harm \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) As the country endures an unprecedented shutdown of public life to slow the spread of the novel coronavirus, more Americans are worried about contracting the illness (57%) than about experiencing severe financial problems from the disruption caused by it (48%). While most of those who are worried about each of these possibilities say they are only "somewhat worried," slightly more are "very worried" about encountering financial hardship (17%) than getting the virus (12%). 635-15 [Americans Feeling Less Connected as Quarantine Life Wears On \(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) Americans increasingly say they feel less connected to family and friends as most of the country is under stay-at-home orders amid the coronavirus pandemic. More than a third of U.S. adults (37%) say they have felt less connected to family and friends in the past week -- an eight-point increase from the 29% Gallup found in late March. Less than half (49%) say they have felt no change in their personal connections -- down slightly from 54% in late March. The percentage who say they feel more connected, 14%, has ebbed slightly over the same time. Women (41%) have become much more likely to report feeling less connected to their friends and family than was the case in March. (Gallup USA)

635-16 [Half of Americans have decided not to use a product or service because of privacy concerns](#) [\(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) At a time when many Americans believe their personal information is less secure and are concerned with how companies and the government use their personal data, a substantial share of the public has opted out of using a product or service because of privacy concerns, according to a Pew Research Center survey conducted June 3-17, 2019. About half (52%) of U.S. adults said they decided recently not to use a product or service because they were worried about how much personal information would be collected about them. (PEW)

635-17 [Lower-income parents most concerned about their children falling behind amid COVID-19 school closures](#) [\(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) With K-12 schools now closed in all 50 states and the District of Columbia because of the coronavirus outbreak, most parents with children in elementary, middle or high school who say their children's school is currently closed (83%) say they are at least somewhat satisfied with the way their children's school has been handling instruction during the closures. Still, roughly two-thirds (64%) express at least some concern about their children falling behind in school, with 28% saying they are very concerned, according to a new Pew Research Center survey. Lower-income parents express more concern than those in higher-income groups about their children potentially falling behind. (PEW)

635-18 [U.S. concern about climate change is rising, but mainly among Democrats](#) [\(Click for Details\)](#)

(USA) The share of Americans who say global climate change is a major threat to the well-being of the United States has grown from 44% in 2009 to 60% this year. But the rise in concern has largely come from Democrats. Opinions among Republicans on this issue remain largely unchanged. About nine-in-ten Democrats (88%, including independents who lean to the party) now consider climate change a major threat to the nation, according to a Pew Research Center survey conducted March 3-29. That's up 27 percentage points from a 2009 survey. Concern about climate change has increased among both liberal Democrats and moderate or conservative Democrats (rising 20 and 27 points, respectively). (PEW)

635-19 [Facebook and YouTube strong across all Generations but Pinterest, Instagram and TikTok have important user bases](#) [\(Click for Details\)](#)

(Australia) As Australia's leading Social Network, Facebook is the most popular Social Network across several generations. Facebook is used by 65% of Pre-Boomers (born pre-1946), 86% of Baby Boomers (1946-

1960), 87% of Gen X (1961-1975) and 90% of Millennials (1976-1990). Video streaming site YouTube is the most popular Social Network for the two youngest Generations used by 91% of Gen Z (1976-1990) and 72% of Generation Alpha (2006-). However, beneath these two market leaders differences in preferences really stand out. Photo-sharing site Pinterest is the third most popular Social Network for both Pre-Boomers (used by 20%) and Baby Boomers (32%) while Instagram is the third most popular choice for Gen X (40%), Millennials (61%), Gen Z (69%) and Generation Alpha (19%). **(Roy Morgan)**

635-20 [YouGov's international COVID-19 tracker reveals changing global attitudes towards the Coronavirus \(Click for Details\)](#)

The biggest changes in fear levels this week in YouGov's 26-market COVID-19 tracker were in Canada and Denmark. Both nations saw a 9-point drop in the number of people saying they are very or fairly scared they will catch the disease, from 69% to 60% in Canada and from 53% to 44% in Denmark. Figures are largely stable elsewhere. The largest increase in fear levels occurred in Sweden, rising from 47% to 53%. The most dramatic behavioural shift since the previous took place in Singapore, where the proportion of people donning face masks in public skyrocketed from 37% to 73%. The previous week's 37% had already been an all-time high, with the public of the island nation now in line with the rest of Asia when it comes to covering their faces. **(YouGov)**

635-21 [Africans Face COVID-19 With Health and Healthcare Problems \(Click for Details\)](#)

Since sub-Saharan Africa reported its first confirmed case of COVID-19 in late February in Lagos, Nigeria, African governments and much of the international health community have prepared for a potential humanitarian calamity. And yet, two and a half months later, the region has roughly 10,000 confirmed cases and fewer than 700 deaths to date. While African populations and their national health systems continue to prepare for the potential for increased transmission across the continent, recent World Poll data indicate how Africa might handle a virus that has already stretched health systems in some rich countries to the breaking point. **(Gallup USA)**

In the previous update of the directory (April 07 – April 13), 280 polls were accumulated. The newly added countries for the current week are marked in **red**, and the repeated countries with new polls added are marked in **purple**. The polls touch upon the following key issues: General awareness about the virus, perceived threat, impact on daily life, satisfaction with government responses to the situation, and financial impact of Coronavirus.
